



## Your Neighborhood Wilderness Program Registration

**Your Neighborhood Wilderness program** includes a 1.5 hour classroom presentation and a 1.5 hour guided field study investigation.

### **Classroom Presentation & Field Study Investigation**

This program introduces students to their local backyard ecosystems. The 1 hour classroom presentation incorporates a power point presentation and scavenger hunt. The 1.5 hour field study will be performed at your school, Camp Schoenwald or at Seahurst Park's 169 acres of woodland trails.

*Teachers will choose from three possible focus areas:*

- 1: **"Who's Bugging You?"**- Terrestrial Invertebrate Identification (Grades K-2)
- 2: **"What's Under Your Feet?"**- Soil and Plants (Grades 2-5)
- 3: **"What's Above Your Head?"**- Birds and Biodiversity (Grades 6-12)

*All three focus areas can be offered as a classroom only session and can include exploration of the schoolyard for the field study component.*

### Program Details

**Location:** Class visits are held at your school.

**Field trip locations:** At your school, Camp Schoenwald or at Seahurst Park's 169 acres of wooded trails.

**Busing:** You need to arrange and pay for transportation for this field trip. It is helpful to register with another class.

**Cost:** \$50 for the 1 hour classroom presentation and \$150 for the 1.5 hour field study. If your school has 50 % or greater reduced or free lunch rate, your course fee may be waived (please request waiver).

**Billing:** An invoice will be sent upon scheduling the course.
